

# HAVILA HOTEL GEIRANGER DOG POLICY

*For you and your dog, a home away from home.*

Dogs are considered a member of the family at the Havila Hotel Geiranger, so we'd be delighted to accommodate them. You can be sure that during your stay with us, your dog will enjoy the same relaxing accommodation as you do.

To keep your pet, you, and our other guests happy, safe, and comfortable, we ask that pet owners act responsibly and follow the guidelines listed below:

- We welcome dogs that are current on vaccinations. Proof of vaccinations from a licensed veterinarian is required.
- Maximum of 2 dogs per guest room allowed.
- For up to seven (7) nights, guests must pay a one-time, nonrefundable fee of 300kr per guestroom. After that, there is an extra charge of 100 kr for each additional night. Excluding service animals.
- Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dog on hotel property including grounds, so please immediately remove and dispose of any waste. If the dog makes a lot of mess, there can be an extra charge for cleaning.
- Always keep an eye on your dog when on the premises. When outside of your guestroom, keep your dog on a leash and in a crate when left in your guestroom unattended.
- The Hotel reserves the right to remove a dog from the premises when it exhibits aggressive behavior, regardless of breed, type, size, weight, etc.
- Your dog is not permitted in the restaurants, lounges, on any furniture in the lobby, or in meeting rooms.
- As a courtesy to other hotel guests, noise levels should be kept to a minimum. If your dog is barking too much, someone will get in touch with you to ask for compliance. Your dog needs rest just like you. We want you to enjoy your stay.
- Additionally, guests need to be responsible for any property damage that might occur because of their pet.
